MUSICVILLE - THE GREEN EUROPEAN OPERA in three acts and three countries:

An impressive, comprehensive, immersive musical experience.

Musicville is an EU-project between Slovenia, Austria and Croatia that transforms the classical European musical form of opera through innovative and creative collaboration. The result is three different stories inspired by environmental awareness, nature, local crafts and traditions. The focus is on sustainable, participatory and interdisciplinary artistic practices from various disciplines such as music, theatre, dance, architecture, visual arts, design and performance.

Between August and October 2024, the performances of these artistic collaborations will take place in three rural and exceptional locations in the partner countries. In addition to the theme of collaboration and community development, a key objective is to contribute to the development of tourism and the revitalisation of cultural, economic and social life in rural areas.

In Austria, the second act of the opera entitled 'Reflections on Friendship' will take place on 28 September 2024 at 19:30 in the Pavel House, Pavlova hiša, the cultural centre of the Slovenian minority in Styria in Bad Radkersburg.

The starting point of the experience is a walk at 17:00 from the city centre to the venue, accompanied by local songs, hospitality and culinary tradition. The audience is then invited to an immersive musical experience that takes place next to an oversized bird's nest, the symbol of home, cosiness and a place where freedom is gained. This narrative invites people to REFLECTIONS ON FRIENDSHIP (reflections on the meaning of friendship).

Reflections on the values that build on the foundation of friendship and its connection to nature. A path marked with green circles and QR codes will continue to lead friends to the house outside the city and invite them to visit this place of genuine human encounters.
